Budget updates

Because of university budget cuts and inflation, Westlaw will be canceled by the end of the fiscal year and Web of Science or Scopus will be canceled by the end of the calendar year for a combined total of \$100,000.

The possible scenarios for future cuts are as follows:

3% cut:	Collections \$25k	Salaries \$50k
4% cut:	Collections \$25k	Salaries \$75k
5% cut:	Collections \$25k	Salaries \$100k

Three winners are chosen with awards of \$400, \$800, and \$1600.

This initiative is to encourage faculty to put textbooks on reserve for students to use for a maximum of three hours. This is not to replace purchasing textbooks but may help those students who cannot afford to buy one.
