MINUTES

1.0 Call to Order: 12:15PM

2.0 Guest: Geoff LoCicero, Director of Web Services

Mr. LoCicero gave an overview of the current status of USM web services with a focus on the problems and concerns that must be addressed to update the content and design of the USM web pages. Over 150 websites must be moved to a new server. Templates need to be established to set standards to expedite the process. To complete revisions in four to six months there will be tight deadlines to meet. While the structure will be standardized, content is unique per department or unit. Site map planning and thinking about how a department is organized and what to include, such as degrees offered and course descriptions, will determine content. Functionality of the open source web software Droople.com includes a web tool box, slideshow, video, and a photo gallery, links, menus and 'permablocks' that are moveable. Content will be easy to update, is password protected and will be searchable by keyword. Statistical analysis to track use/traffic of web pages is an added feature that will inform departments about success in site navigation and access to information about their programs. Maintenance of department or unit websites is a concern for departments who may not have staff with appropriate skills to update information routinely. Web Services will provide support, training and other fee-based services as requested.

 - Digital Measures (DM) has been purchased to measure faculty productivity. A pilot implementation will be done in CoAL. Greatest challenge will be adding faculty data from current CVs after which faculty can update information annually. DM will be able to generate annual reports for evaluations; there are several model variations that can be used.
 - The fifth year SACS review is due March 25, 2012. Standard reports will be due including credential reports for program directors. Currently working ahead to gather data in preparation of the report.

 - Completion of online CITI training modules is required for graduate students and faculty with graduate teaching status in compliance with federal mandates. Due to the amount of time necessary to complete the modules, there has been some push back by faculty particularly those
