Lisa Jones Receives University Libraries Staff Excellence Award

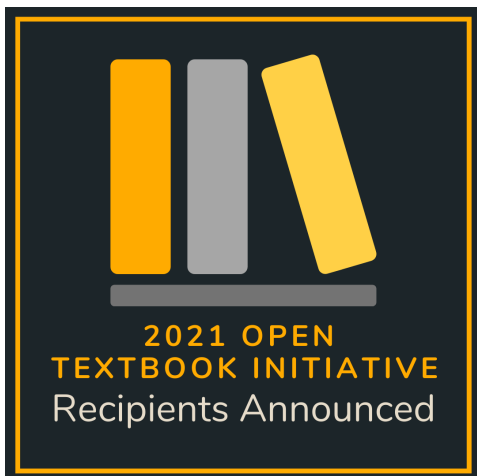
Lisa Jones, head of Library Technology, was presented the University Libraries Staff Excellence Award on December 9. Jones has served University Libraries for over 24 years.

In January 2012, Aquila launched as the institutional repository for The University of Southern Mississippi. Initially, Aquila held only a small number of faculty publications, a collection of honors theses, and a single journal. In January of 2022, Aquila celebrated its 10th anniversary with over 18,000 documents, downloaded over 4.25 million times. The first ten years have been a whirlwind of exponential growth, and we are excited to see what the next ten years have in store.
