Black Selected to Attend Librarians Active Learning Institute at Dartmouth College



Hali Black, first year experience librarian, has been selected to attend the Librarians Active Learning Institute (LALI) at Dartmouth College. LALI will be conducted virtually, with classes held on seven days, spread out over two weeks.

LALI helps librarians and archivists develop and refine their skills as learner-centered teachers, instructional designers, and collaborators by introducing them to the practice of active learning pedagogy—that is, pedagogy in which students are made active collaborators in the common endeavor of research instruction. During LALI, participants will experience what it is like to be students in an active learning environment, in that the facilitators not only "talk the talk" but also "walk the walk" of active learning.
