  - GCFC Bylaws
    - o Existing Language for Section 212 of the GCFC Bylaws:
      - Each of the following academic divisions of the University shall be entitled
        to at least 1 representative to the Council: College of Arts and Letters;
         College of Business; College of Education and Psychology; the College of
        Health; College of Science and Technology; College of Nursing; and full-

time faculty members from the Gulf Coast Libraries, Stennis Space Center, and the Gulf Coast Research Laboratory shall also be entitled to elect at least 1 representative each to the Council. Whenever the number of faculty assigned to any one of these units reaches a threshold of 30 full-time faculty members, that unit shall be entitled to elect a second representative to the Council.

One additional at-large member of the Council shall be elected by the entire Gulf Coast full-time faculty assigned to the units described above.

### o Proposed New Language:

Each of the following academic divisions of the University shall be entitled to at least 1 representative to the Council: School of Leadership, School of Coastal Resilience, and School of Ocean Science and Engineering; and full-time faculty members from the Gulf Coast Libraries shall also be entitled to elect at least 1 representative to the Council. Full-time faculty who are housed on the coast but whose academic unit does not reside on the coast or not directly represented above will be represented by at least 1 representative. All of the above constituencies shall be entitled to 1 representative plus 1 additional member per 10 full-time additional faculty in that constituencies.
