


# Workflow/Responsibilities

#### **Graduate School**

- Sent Updates
  - Change in access, abstract updates


#### <u>Library</u>

- Submitted requests to vendor re: site structure, customizations
- Organized Metadata
- Downloaded, formatted, and named files
- Received and tracked permission forms
- Uploaded content to IR



## Challenges

- Technology
  - Can't have embedded PDF viewer and restricted access
  - Metadata from Graduate School
  - Separate book galleries
    - Is batch uploading/revision worth it?
- Workflows/Communication
  - Lots of e-mails between Symposium coordinator and IR manager
  - Students/advisors changing their mind re: access level
  - Getting permission forms and files
  - Supervising remote student worker




So How'd it Go?
